The 125th Working Committee meeting of the Indian Federation of Working Journalists (IFWJ) will be held at Raipur at 10 a.m. on Sunday, 13 September 2015. The Chhattisgarh Chief Minister Dr. Raman Singh will inaugurate the session. The following business will be transacted in the meeting.

1. Proposals to amend the IFWJ constitution.
2. Approval of minutes of last working committee meetings at Guwahati and Bhubaneswar.
3. Report by state unit on follow-up action on Supreme Court direction to State Chief Secretaries (28 April, 2015).


